



| Card | Not showing good learning behaviour | Consequences |

| Everyone starts on a green card | | |
| | 1st warning | You will stay on a green card. |
| | 2 nd warning | You will move to a yellow card. |
| | 3 rd warning | You will stay on a yellow card and have time out IN CLASS for a set amount of time. |
| | Final warning | You will move to a red card, go to work in your buddy class and go to Reflection at playtime . |
| | If you are on a red card and still choose to do the wrong thing | You will go to see Mrs Cordle and work outside her office for a set amount of time. You will stay there at playtime/lunchtime. |
| | Some choices will automatically mean a red card: • Any physical harm such as hitting, thumping or kicking • Verbal abuse to adults • Bullying or racist comments • Rude actions | You will go to Mrs Cordle's office and you will be told what will happen. Any physical assault to adults will be dealt with immediately by a fixed term exclusion or an exclusion. This will also be the consequence for physical assault on children depending on the nature of the attack. |
| | If you have made the wrong choices and go to reflection | You will write a letter which will go home to your parents or guardians that explains why you have gone to reflect on your choices. |
| If you have made the wrong choices and been to Reflection 3 times in a week | | Your parents will be asked to come into school to see Mrs Needham or Mrs Cordle. |
| If you get a lunchtime slip | | Your teacher will decide what happens next. |
| Reflection | | The number of times you have gone to reflection will be monitored and this may result in losing your treat if your house is the winning team. |
